2021 continued to be full of unprecedented challenges with the COVID-19 pandemic that impacted the Solano homeless system of care and community in significant ways and required the JPA to work with more expediency, coordination, and flexibility than ever before. Despite these challenges, the JPA was able to achieve incredible outcomes with their partners in 2021, several of which are highlighted below.

Project Roomkey provided 316 homeless individuals with housing, food and supportive services to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 among the homeless community.



In 2021, Resource Connect Solano made 857 referrals and the DV-CES made 158 referrals for services and housing.



In 2021, the JPA/CoC started Solano's first ever Lived Experience Advisory Committee with 15 members.



In 2021, HMIS showed 351 exits to Permanent Housing (PSH, RRH, and other forms of permanent housing)



JPA Approved the hiring of their first full time dedicated staff !
